

The Portland Area Comprehensive Transportation Committee (PACTS) is undertaking the process of developing a regional, Tri-Community Transportation Plan for the communities of Saco, Biddeford, and Old Orchard Beach. This plan will be a regional plan which will take into account current land use patterns and the transportation network, determine what changes to land use and the transportation system are required to sustain and enhance the viability of the communities, and come up with an action strategy, including funding mechanisms, to ensure that the Plan can be implemented. The work will be completed with the participation of the public and is scheduled to be completed by the end of September.

Assisting PACTS in this effort is a consultant team led by Gorrill-Palmer Consulting Engineers Inc. who has teamed with Planning Decisions, Inc., Maine Tomorrow, Nelson /Nygaard Consulting Associates, and KMJ Consulting.
